Accreditation

Accreditation schedule RECHERSWIL

All the licences will be checked.

Numbers are to be fixed visibly to the back of the handbike. The helmet numbers are to be fixed to the helmets on the left, right and front.

Accreditation schedule OENSINGEN

Sunday, 21 June 2015 8.15 – 10.00 AM on the 'Rössli Platz'

Overall Ranking – Race form/calculation

The two races (time trial and road race) in Recherswil and Oensingen will be counted as one race and are reported to the UCI as overall ranking (modus ranking points – when tied the rank in time trial decides).

The event is sanctioned by UCI, therefore the UCI rules will be applied.

Recherswil is located near the A1 motorway (Basel/Bern). Take the A1 exit Kriegstetten/Gerlafingen/Biberist and make a turn to the left to the Gerlafingenstrasse. In the center of Kriegstetten turn right towards Recherswil. From there, you can follow the marked signs.

Bike-Check

All bikes will be checked. The athlete is responsible for providing a regular bike, as well as the proper helmet color. Athletes with non-regular bikes will not be able to start.

The control take place at the accreditation area between 12.30 and 2.30 pm.

Dressing room

Dressing rooms and douches are located in the IGU-hall in Recherswil.

Helmet

The wearing of an officially tested helmet is compulsory for all athletes. The helmet numbers are to be fixed to the helmets on the left, right and front. The athlete is responsible for providing the proper helmet colour or respectively the proper colour vest.

Prize money

The prize money will be based on the overall-ranking Recherswil/Oensingen and will be paid tomorrow from 3 pm in Oensingen.

Distances/Categories

1 lap = 10 km (for all categories the same)

Time interval

Will be 1 minute (with 3 breaks)

If one athlete is late, he can start immediately, but his original start time will be taken as the start time (even if he starts later).

Licence

All competitors must possess a valid UCI license.

Competition venue Recherswil

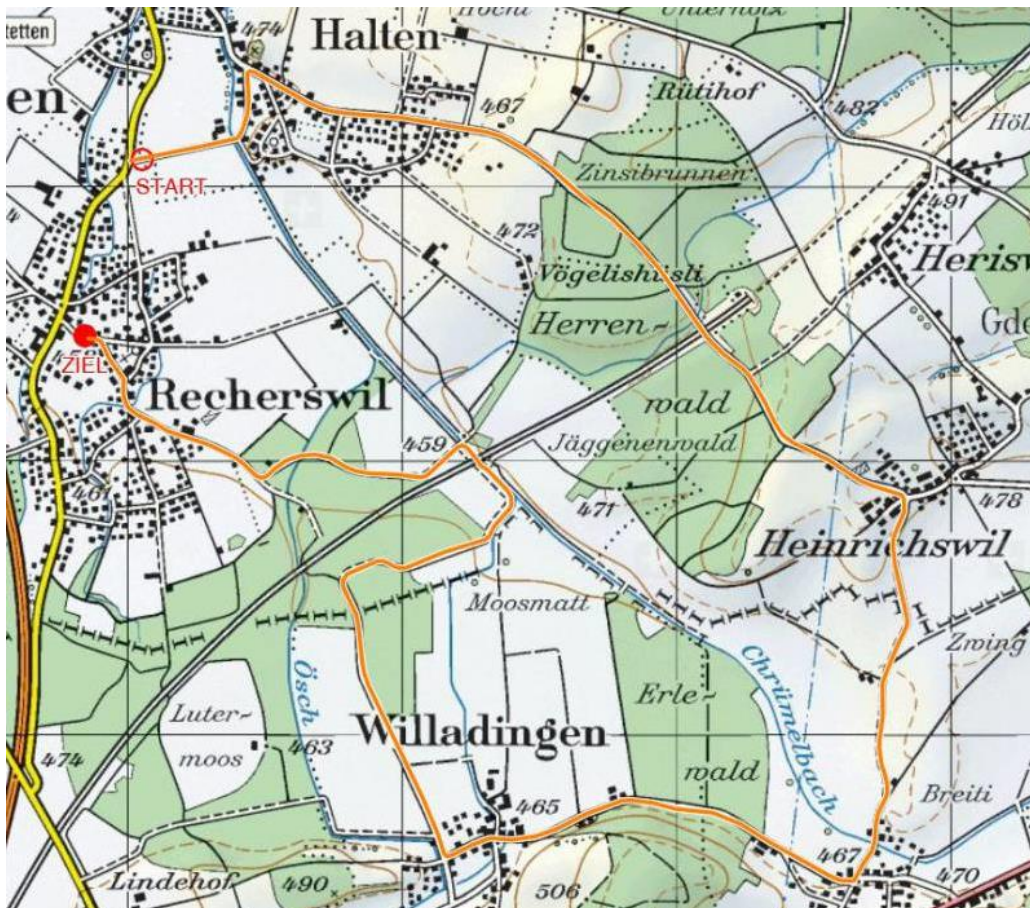
The course is completely closed to traffic from 2.15 pm until 6.00 pm. Crossing and travelling for short stretches through street traffic may be allowed by security personnel.

Route

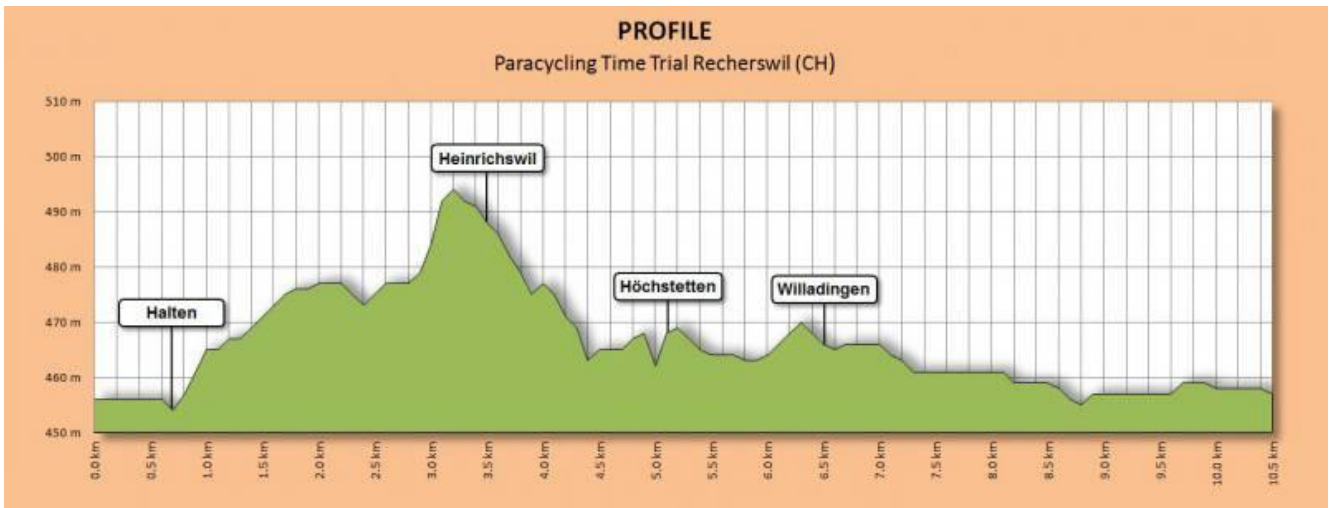
Recherswil - Halten - Heinrichswil - Höchstetten - Willadingen - Recherswil

The route scales 10 kilometres (1 lap = 10 km, all categories).

Sunday, 21 June 2015

Rules

The event is sanctioned by IPC Athletics and UCI Para-cycling.

Technical aspects as well as classifications for Athletics are subject to the rules of the IPC. For para-cyclers UCI rules will be applied.

It is forbidden to make use of the assistance of non-officials. Escort vehicles must not be used for driving in slipstream. Driving in the slipstream in other categories is strictly forbidden and will lead to disqualification.

The athlete is responsible for completing the required number of laps. Time keeping is only a control unit.

Events must not be carried out if they are of no interest to Swiss athletes and/or have too few (less than three) entries. Should an event be cancelled, the athletes will be informed by the organizers.

Time keeping

Electronic data capture by «DataChip». Chips are going to be distributed at accreditation. Personal chips are not allowed.

The transponders will be removed by the organizers at the refreshment point when the last person crosses the line. Whoever has not reached the finish line on time bears the responsibility of ensuring that the transponder is returned. An invoice for payment will be sent to any athlete who fails to return the transponder.

Race end

Last time to reach the finish is 1.15 pm. No athlete will be allowed on the course after this time. From 1.45 pm the course will be fully open to general traffic.

Bike-Check

All Bikes will be checked at the start line, as well as the day before in Recherswil.

Race service

Official race service is provided on the Rössli-Platz in Oensingen by Orthotec AG Nottwil.

Dressing room

Dressing rooms and showers are located at the VEBO. See also the situation map.

Helmet

The wearing of an officially tested helmet is compulsory for all athletes. The helmet numbers are to be fixed to the helmets on the left, right and front.

Information Para-cycling

The athlete is responsible for providing the proper helmet color or respectively the proper color vest.

Presentation ceremony

A flower ceremony for the following selected categories will take place a short distance behind the finish line directly after the race (Official presentation ceremony):

Prize money

There will be paid a prize money of approximately CHF 20'000.–. Some Prizes include price of gold in 5 gram, 2.5 gram and 2 gram.

Licence

All competitors must possess a valid UCI or IPC license.

Competition venue Oensingen

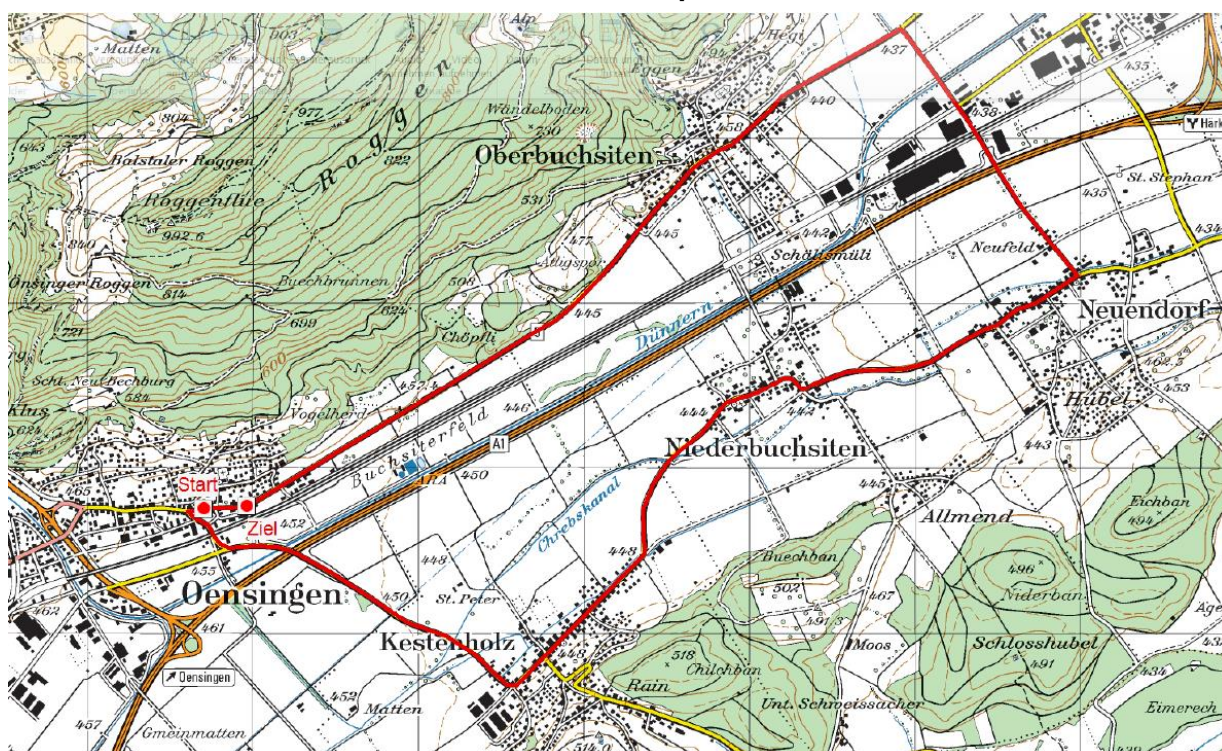
The red marked circuit Oensingen - Oberbuchsiten - Neuendorf - Niederbuchsiten - Kestenholz - Oensingen scales 14 kilometers.

The course is completely closed to traffic. Crossing and travelling for short stretches through street traffic may be allowed by security personnel. In the event of a major traffic accident on the National roadway, the complete closure must be changed to a partial closure. Then right hand traffic is strictly enforced. The instructions of the security personnel are to be followed at all times.

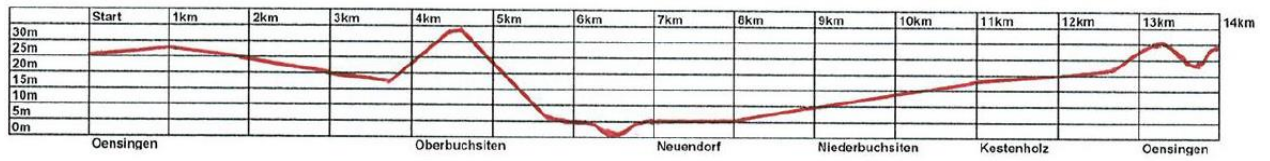
warm up course
